

Conditions

- The Nursery is open 51 weeks of the year, Monday to Friday, 8.00am to 6.00pm (except for Bank Holidays and a week at Christmas). No fees are charged for these days.
- There is a minimum booking of two sessions per week
- Please advise the nursery if you are unable to collect your child as the staff will not release any child unless previously advised.
- We must have up-to-date contact details for all parents in case of emergency.
- Please bring a small bag with spare clothes, clearly labelled.
- Children who have had vomiting or diarrhoea in the past 48 hours, and children suffering from any infectious disease cannot be accepted into nursery. This is in accordance with the North Somerset Area Health Authority guidelines.
- One months notice is required when your child leaves
- All fees are payable in advance, weekly or monthly and are payable even if your child is absent through holidays or illness. This will ensure your child retains their place at nursery.
